Students will learn how to develop meaningful, substantive, and sustainable relationships. (1 to 2 hours) • The Law Enforcement Instrument of National Power: Defines the LEINP and explains why it matters to all law enforcement organizations of National Security. (1 hour) • Leading Change and Innovation: Students will learn skills to effectively lead change and to implement innovation. (1/2 to 1 hour) • Organizational Culture: Students will define and examine the elements of culture. To know it is to control it. (1/2 to 1 hour)
