The first word says it all—MASS. Mass, meaning many citizens, a large-scale incident that happens quickly, without notice, and a high amount of responding resources, often from multiple different agencies. Mass casualty incidents perpetrated by active shooters are showing a disturbing upward trend over the years which compelled the FBI National Academy Associates to create a series of two-day Leadership Forums for first responders throughout the country. The Forum will provide attendees with the knowledge, skills and resources needed to improve initial response, emergency operations center and controlling the communications during/post crisis.

Course Objectives:

- Leaders will gain lessons learned through a comprehensive review of past incidents
- Understanding and response to the dynamics of active assailant situation
- Attendees will increase their knowledge and understanding of multi-agency response: coordinating law enforcement, fire, and EMS
- Controlling the narrative with the press and public during, as well as after the incident
